Subject: DTG update

Ted/Steven,

I made a trip to DTG yesterday to walk the site and observe the subsurface gas investigation that is being done by YRCAA. A summary of my observations are below:

LFG investigation

I walked the property line along the northwest face as well as the perimeter road on the northwest and east side. The gas meter did not register any change in oxygen, methane, carbon monoxide, hydrogen sulfide.
